Overview

Growth Model

The DPS ETF Core Aggressive Growth Model targets robust capital appreciation through active allocation among a diverse array of investment categories. Simplified to a 3-position model, unlike the usual 6 position approach, this strategy diversifies across 29 sectors. It spans from traditional equities to more conservative arenas like inverse government and leveraged debt securities. The model takes a global investment approach, considering international sectors alongside U.S.-based funds. It focuses on attempting to maximize returns by dynamically investing in better -performing sectors. Managed with precision, the model typically executes 10-15 trades annually to adjust to the evolving market landscape.



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
